Four Weeks – four days Jim Clark Revival – 27. – 30. April 2006

- Jim Clark Revival Starts in Four Weeks in Hockenheim
- Four Action Packed Days at the Hockenheimring
- 400 Historic Race and Sports Cars at the Start
- Enormous Meeting for Classic Cars
- World Record Attempt "1000 Oldtimers Built up to 1976 on the Course"

(Hockenheim 27 March 2006) In four weeks, the Jim Clark Revival will take place for the second time at the Hockenheimring. After a successful premiere in 2005, there will be even more historic racing and sports cars this year.

Organiser Ronny G. Bredhauer announces that more than 400 entries have been sent in for the four-day-long event. This includes the historic Formula 1 racing cars, the European Formula 2 Club, the various FIA Historic European Championships for GT and Touring Cars as well as the roaring racers of the Orwell Supersports Cup.

On Saturday evening though, approximately 1000 Oldtimers would gather on the 4,574-kilometre-long track before the gates of Hockenheim. They will be part of a spectacular world record attempt which will be held under the slogan "The largest rolling Automobile Museum of the World" where in the end this will be recorded in the Guinness Book of World Records. Not only have several national and international Automobile Clubs sent in their entries, but individuals with their Oldtimers as well, who do not wish to miss this spectacle. This part of the programme is certainly going to be the absolute Highlight of the four-day-long event. If you add these 1000 vehicles to those that will be fighting hot duels on the race course during the four days, then already in the second year of existence, the Jim Clark Revival has very good chances of securing the title of "largest Oldtimer Event in 2006".

The Jim Clark Revival is held in memory of the sympathetic Scotsman, who had won 25 Grand Prix races with his Lotus, who twice became Formula 1 World Champion in 1963 and 1965 and who met with a fatal accident during a Formula 2 race at Hockenheim. Several former drivers who were Jim Clark's rivals in his active time, like for example the present FIA President Max Mosley, Hubert Hahne, Kurt Ahrens or John Surtees, are expected to attend the Jim Clark Revival.

The admission fees for the four-day-spectacle are especially suitable for families – the weekend ticket costs 25,- Euro; Teenagers up to 16 years of age enjoy free admission. Families from Hockenheim will receive a voucher for two free admission tickets. They all can all expect a programme filled to the tilt during the four days of the Jim Clark Revival (see attached Timetable).
